Risks & Contrarian Views

- Regulatory Uncertainty in digital property rights.
- Platform Obsolescence risks in evolving metaverse ecosystems.
- Speculative Bubble concerns similar to NFT mania.



Action Steps

1. Allocate assets across physical & digital real estate (70/30 ratio).
2. Use location intelligence for virtual land acquisition.
3. Structure holdings for tax efficiency across jurisdictions.
4. Engage specialist advisors for dual-asset family office strategies.
